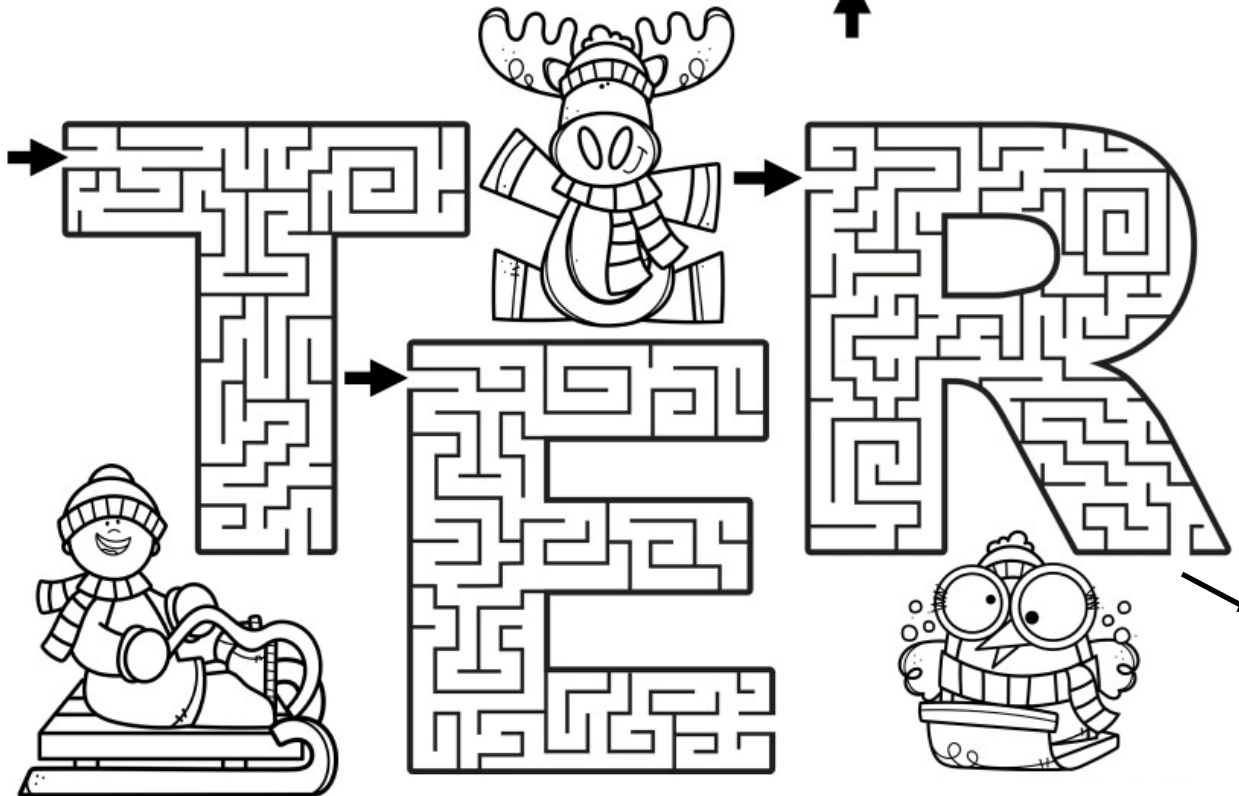
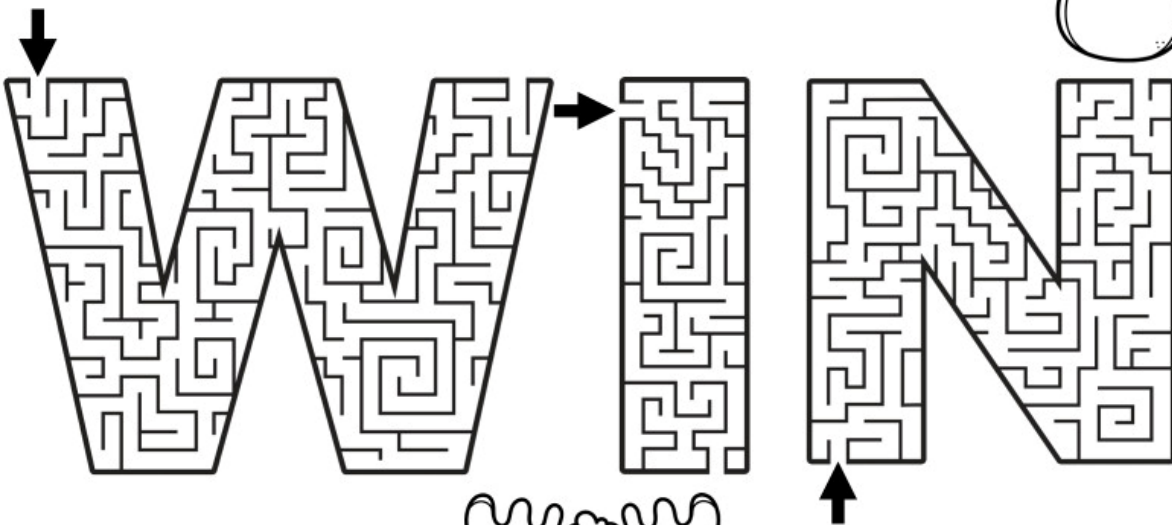
## A-Maze-ing Mazes!
